R13 - Storing of waste before using any of the R1 to R12 activities

D14 - Placing into other packaging prior to any of the D1 to D12 activities

D15 - Storage before implementing any of the D1 to D14 activities

C.10 Permitted wastes

C.10.1 Permitted categories and types of wastes

No wastes other than those which are categorised below in Table C.10.1 and specified in detail in Schedule 5 attached to these conditions shall be accepted at the site

C.10.2 Permitted quantities of wastes

The quantities of wastes accepted shall not exceed those listed in Table C.10.1. Whilst complying with the maximum quantities specified for each type of waste, the total quantity of waste accepted at the site per year shall not exceed 165060 tonnes
